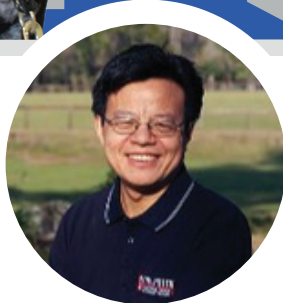

Definitely! As long as you have completed an acupuncture course offered by the Chi University, or organization (IVAS, and etc.), you are welcome to register for this course.

No. Registration for the course includes both the online and on-site portions of the course. Because this course is based heavily on the hands-on wet labs, the on-site portion is essential to the full understanding of the course material.
