





CVA PROGRAM OVERVIEW



The course begins with an overview of fundamental aspects of Chinese Medicine, including *Yin-Yang* and *Five Elements* theory, which serve as a foundation for

case diagnoses and treatment presented later in the class. A variety of acupuncture techniques are taught, including electro-acupuncture, aqua-acupuncture, moxibustion, etc. in addition to conventional "dry" needling. Three track options are available - small animal, horses and mixed practice (which includes both small animals and horses). In acupoint labs, students learn acupuncture points on dogs, horses or both dogs and horses depending on the selected track.

The course is presented in 3 online sessions and 2 on-site sessions. Online segments include lectures and case demos that students can stream at their convenience. On-site segments give students the opportunity to learn acupuncture points on live animals in small acupoint lab groups of four to six students per instructor. The on-site segment of this course is located in Reddick, Florida, United States.
