Vintage: 2024

Fruit: Raspberries and Blackberries

Honey: Raw Wildflower - Northwoods Apiaries

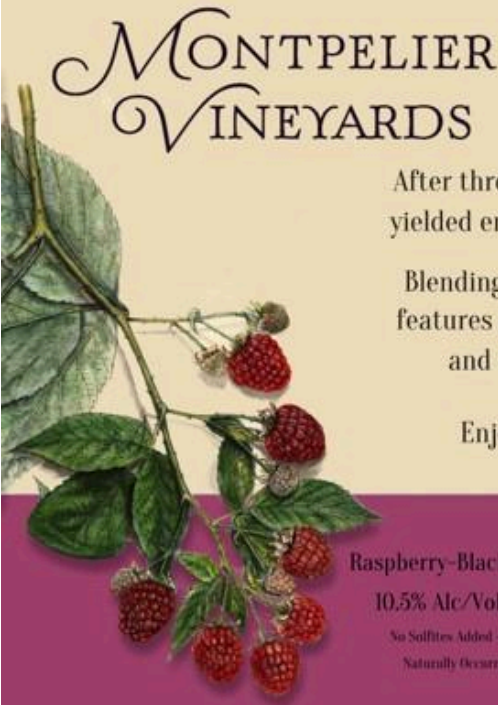
Alcohol: 11.5%

Winemaking Notes: Raspberries and blackberries were combined with raw honey and spring water, undergoing fermentation for several weeks before being pressed. The fermentation process then continued in glass demijohns for ten months before the final product was bottled.

Tasting Notes: This mead was made with local raw honey and berries from our Washington, Vermont site. It has a deep red color and crystal clarity. On the nose, berries dominate with floral undertones of the honey. On the palate
