Individuals can ride fare-free to area voting centers on Tuesday, November 4th

(Corpus Christi, Texas) – Corpus Christi Regional Transportation Authority (CCRTA) will offer fare-free rides to and from voting centers on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4th. Passengers simply need to inform their Bus Operator that they are traveling to or from a voting center to ride for free -- no voter registration or ID is required when boarding.

- Premium Services (Park & Ride)
- Rural On-Demand Services (Paisano)
